St John (NSW) Cadets are young people who undertake training in pre-hospital emergency care and a variety of proficiency subjects from cooking to employment preparation.

Cadets develop extensive First Aid skills, life skills, communication and leadership skills. Once they are trained members may attend duties under adult supervision. Juniors are aged between 8 and 11 years, and cadets are aged from 11 to 17 years.

“Many young volunteers have found St John Cadets to be a valuable stepping-stone for careers as an ambulance officer, nurse or in medicine.

The Division meets on Wednesday nights from 7pm-9pm (Public holidays excluded) at St John House, 6 Hunt Street Surry Hills, which is just a five minute walk from Central Station.
