Local volunteers provide first aid in Armidale and surrounding areas, attending events such as The Armidale Show, Wool Expo, Rodeo's, Motorbike race days, concerts, cycling and sporting events. St John volunteers are highly trained with nationally recognised qualifications. The division meets every second Wednesday at the Armidale School at 6:30pm.
