On Sunday March 14, 2010, an explosion of enthusiasm will take over Parramatta Park for the first ever St John (NSW) Walk&Talk, an event dedicated to celebrating the work St John does in the community.

The inaugural Walk&Talk is an opportunity to share the belief in St John and the difference we make in the lives of others.

The whole Western Suburbs Cadet Division has registered to participate in the fun run.

Superintendent Peter Dixon believes it is important for the cadets to take part.

"It is a great opportunity for the cadets to participate in an event instead of sitting on the sidelines as part of a duty. They are having a great time and are well underway with their fundraising to reach our division's target of \$5000" he said.
