12 March 2010. St John Ambulance Australia (NSW) will host its first ever Walk&Talk this Sunday at Parramatta Park.

Over 300 volunteers, staff, donors, customers, suppliers, families and all those who share the spirit of the work St John does in the community will walk 3 or 6 km to celebrate the work St John does in the community. The walk will be followed by an afternoon picnic with BBQ and entertainment.

St John (NSW) aims to raise an ambitious \$180,000 to purchase a fully equipped Communication Bus, which will be used by First Aid Services volunteers during major events like the City2Surf or New Years Eve, as well as community emergencies such as bushfires and floods.

The Hon Peter Collins AM QC, Chairman of St John (NSW) said the event also aims to raise the charity's profile.

"The most important aspect of the Walk&Talk is the actual talk.

"From first aid to early literacy and immunisation, our people give up their time willingly and regularly to provide a service they believe in. The Walk&Talk is about sharing with others this belief in St John and the difference we make in the lives of others", he said.
