

INFANTILE CONVULSIONS

1. During convulsions:

- place child on floor for safety
- turn child on side
- do not restrain child.

2. After convulsions:

- follow DRABCD
- remove excessive clothing or wrapping
- seek medical aid.



SIGNS & SYMPTOMS

- fever
- twitching of face or limbs
- eyes rolling up
- congestion of face and neck
- blue face and lips
- stiffness of body with arched back
- unconsciousness.

WARNING

Do not cool child by sponging or bathing.
