■ What is a body fluid spill?

The most common type of body fluid spills that occur in the workplace, at home or in public domains are vomit, blood, faeces and urine.

Many factors contribute to these spills including people with disease or general illness, workplace accidents, pregnancy, medication, injection of illicit and non-illicit drugs to over indulgence.

■ What is the danger?

Many of these body fluid spills can contain “blood borne pathogens”, or infectious disease. Unprotected exposure to these spills when attempting to clean up an area potentially exposes people to contracting these diseases.

In many cases, people causing these spills are not even aware they have a serious infectious disease!

The most serious and widespread concern is exposure to Hepatitis B and C as well as HIV. Not only are these diseases life threatening, they can be contracted by direct contact with infected blood or fluid.

■ How should we protect ourselves? (and the current legislation)

The National OH&S Commission now require:
ALL body fluid spills be treated as potentially infectious.

People cleaning these spills must have personal protective equipment.

The spill must be contained with a non toxic odour and moisture absorbent.

The spill must NOT be washed up with standard domestic equipment such as mop & bucket due to cross contamination.

Suitable for: Public transport vehicles, taxis, medical centres, sporting venues, pubs, clubs, hotels, schools, workplaces and shopping centres.
